In accordance with Vermont's campaign finance law (17 V.S.A. §2901), the SBBA PAC does not give contributions to candidates, political committees, or political parties. Contribution limits do not apply to independent expenditure-only PACs. Both corporate and personal checks are allowed. You do not have to be a member of SBBA to donate. Contributions are not tax deductible. All decisions on how to spend PAC funds are determined by the SBBA PAC Government Affairs Committee, appointed by the South Burlington Business Association Board of Directors.
