The South Burlington Business Association supports an asphalt paved shareduse path across Hubbard Park.

We agree with the South Burlington Bicycle and Pedestrian Committee (SBBPC) that the path should be paved and maintained to the same standard as the rest of city's shared-use paths. The current design of Hubbard Park anticipates this shared use path across the park to provide for bike and pedestrian access from both the north and south. The Hubbard Park path is an integral part of South Burlington's network for bike riders and pedestrians, providing a safe alternative form of transportation. Paving the path will also ensure equity by providing accessibility for people of all ages and abilities.
